United Way of Greater Rochester and the Finger Lake's mission is to unite the good will and resources of the Greater Rochester community so that everyone can thrive.

United Way of Greater Rochester and the Finger Lakes invests \$11 million for 185 partner programs within the sixcounty region for 2024. These partners use research and prevention to get the best results to help all of Rochester thrive. All programs and initiatives supported by United Way's Community Fund are monitored, measured and evaluated regularly to confirm they're achieving positive results for our community and local people in need.

Our impact with partner programs across the region makes significant differences across our impact areas:

- Over \$6 million is invested in our access to health impact area where individuals and families have their basic needs met, safe places to live, and prenatal to birth services.
- Over \$3 million is invested in our education impact area that engages youth from the ages birth to 21 for primary school, secondary school, afterschool, and summer program enrichment for over a 1000 youth across the region.
- Over \$900,000 is invested in our economic mobility area where assistance is provided for gaining great jobs, effectively managing resources, and engaging learning development opportunities for upward mobility.
