SUMMARY

The Budget Analyst is responsible for preparing and posting journal entries, reconciling general ledger accounts and closing end-of-month accounts for certain projects. Additionally, this position will prepare and analyze budgets for these projects.

- Research complex accounting issues and errors to find solutions
- Submit budget summaries and narratives as necessary to senior management for monthly review.
