SUMMARY

The Community Impact Associate is a member of the Community Impact (CI) Team and is responsible for supporting the strategies that achieve positive measurable results in assigned focus areas of funding for United Way's portfolios. This position is responsible for supporting both Impact and Innovation Grants which involve investments in immediate and emerging community needs. The Community Impact Associate is responsible for keeping current on relevant data and research related to assigned impact area (Education, Economic Mobility, and Health). This position is also responsible for monitoring and reporting agencies' progress toward deliverables, supporting capacity building of funded agencies, and fostering and maintaining strong relationships with community stakeholders for the overall good of the community. This position also manages Project Uplift across counties.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Responsible for supporting the Economic Mobility portfolio of funded agencies in achieving measurable results in alignment with the overall impact agenda
- Responsible for managing Project Uplift in a multi-county setting including but not limited to strategy development, planning and prioritizing, problem solving, decision making, funding, evaluating and analysis, meeting deadlines, meeting goals and desired outcomes
- Responsible for approaching and engaging organizations in innovative ways to engage client/community voice to identify needs and create solutions

- Partners with funded agencies to track program results, to monitor budget needs, to support deliverables, and to share results to amplify impact
- Maintains an awareness of goals and objectives and navigates solutions towards desired ends, while maintaining relationships and supporting consensus. Uses all available information appropriately to guide decisions and negotiations to meet objectives, while acting with integrity
- Supports the application process for funding from partner agencies for impact and innovation grants
- Assists the Community Impact Specialists with identifying lessons learned from evaluation findings and is a thought partner for recommendations to agency partners, community stakeholders and the CI team
- With the support of the Community Impact Specialists, facilitates communication and interaction among the program stakeholders
- Collaborates with internal departments, including the Marketing and Communications team and the Resource Development team, to further United Way's community impact strategies and community focus. Works cross functionally with Rochester Monroe-Anti Poverty Initiative and Systems Integration Project where applicable to align with community focused initiatives and projects to improve the lives of community members
- Consistently demonstrates the values and mission of United Way
- Performs other duties as assigned
